In March 2025, **The National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC)** launched their *NEW* early learning program quality assessment and accreditation system.

The Office of Early Childhood (OEC) is continuing our partnership with NAEYC to **pay NAEYC accreditation fees** for NAEYC-eligible Connecticut early care and education (ECE) programs through June 30, 2026.
